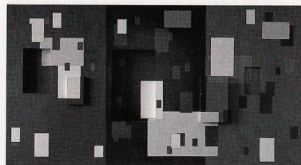

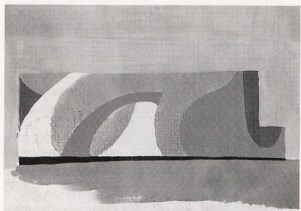
Exhibitions are held in the Outpatients' Foyer at the hospital in Homerton Row, E9, which is open Monday - Friday, 9am - 5pm.
